LOW RISK SYMPTOMS:

Fever 100
Congestion/ Runny Nose
Sore throat, Headache
Nausea/ Vomiting, Diarrhea
Muscle Pain
*child is showing 1 of the symptoms



Return to school:

* after 24 hours of complete symptom resolution and fever free without using medication

HIGH RISK SYMPTOMS:

Cough
Difficulty Breathing
Loss of smell and/or taste
Fever of 100.4 or higher
*child is showing 1 of the high risk symptoms
*child is showing 2 or more of the low risk symptoms
SEEK MEDICAL ADVICE



ALTERNATIVE DIAGNOSIS (Strep, Flu, etc)



Return to school:

* after 24-48 hours of complete symptom resolution and fever free without using medication
* Note from Doctor to return

EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

Exposure is direct/ close contact of student/teacher/staff to an individual who tested positive to COVID-19 and one spent time around the individual at a 6 ft distance for 10 minutes or more.



QUARANTINE for 14 days must complete



If symptoms develop within 14 days of exposure
SEEK MEDICAL ADVICE



COVID - 19 DIAGNOSIS
(clinical symptoms + test)
ISOLATE
(minimum of 10 days since start of symptoms)



Return to school:

* after 24-48 hours of complete symptom resolution and fever free without using medication
* Note from Doctor to return



CDC guidelines to clear people back to work/ school after testing positive:

For most persons with COVID-19 illness, isolation and precautions can generally be discontinued 10 days after symptom onset and resolution of fever for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medications, and with improvement of other symptoms.
For persons who never develop symptoms, isolation and other precautions can be discontinued 10 days after the date of their first positive RT-PCR test for COVID -19.
